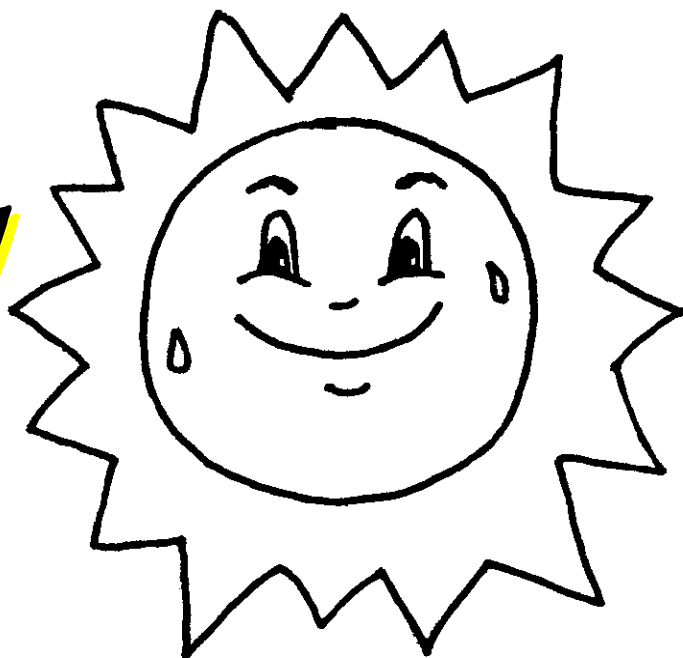


Don't Leave Kids in Hot Cars!
