

# TRAVEL SAFELY

*~With many people traveling for Thanksgiving,  
here are some tips to make sure  
that you and your family travel safely ~*

## **In the car:**

Everyone in the vehicle should be buckled up - either in a seat belt, booster seat or car seat.

Kids under 13 should never ride in the front seat.

Make sure all loose objects are secured in the car. A loose umbrella or snow scraper could cause injury if the vehicle stops suddenly or crashes.

## **In the air:**

Kids under 40 pounds should ride in a car seat on an airplane. The car seat should be in the window seat so it doesn't block other passengers.

Make sure that your car seat can be used on the plane, look for a label that says, "This Restraint is Certified for Use in Motor Vehicles and Aircraft".

Listen carefully during the airline safety briefing and be sure that your child is not seated in an emergency exit row.

Make sure that the vehicle you will be riding in when you reach your destination has an adequate number of safe seating positions and safety belts.



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
