



Winter Home Safety

As the days get colder, be sure to stay warm and safe with these tips ~



Place space heaters at least 3 feet away from areas where children play, curtains and furniture.



Supervise children at all times when a space heater is in use.



Be sure that the fireplace flue is open before lighting a fire.



Burn only seasoned wood in fireplaces and woodstoves - not cardboard, newspaper or trash. These items burn unevenly and may contain toxins.



Use sturdy screens or doors to keep embers inside the fireplace, and to keep kids out.



Install a Carbon Monoxide detector on each floor of your home, and near sleeping areas.
